



IFS COVID19 CONFERENCE PROTOCOL

We request that all delegates carry out a covid test (either PCR or lateral flow) before travelling.

No delegates can come to the conference if they have covid symptoms, have been advised to isolate, or are awaiting results from a PCR test. We will offer a full refund in these circumstances, up to one week before the conference. Thereafter any refund is at the discretion of the organisers.

We will provide a limited number of lateral flow tests for the use of delegates who request them while at the conference.

We request delegates to use the sanitising stations that will be provided, and wash their hands frequently.

We recommend to delegates that they wear face masks in public / crowded spaces within the college buildings (not required when seated in the auditorium).

Robinson College are continuing to implement an enhanced cleaning regime for both public spaces and bedrooms.

Given the anticipated number of delegates, most should be able to occupy alternate seats in the auditorium, to maintain social distancing, and we encourage you to do so.

External doors and windows will be kept open wherever possible.

We will set up a one way walking system between the restaurant / main hall and auditorium.

We will use a 'tidal flow' one way system to enter and leave the auditorium. What this means in practice is that, at the beginning of a session, once you have entered the auditorium, please do not come out again (thus going against 'the flow'), and the reverse at the end of a session.

We request that delegates avoid loitering in the Auditorium Foyer and other potentially congested spaces. Also, when arriving at the college, please avoid crowding into the Porters Lodge when registering.

There will not be the normal pre-dinner reception on the balcony. Instead pre-dinner drinks will be served downstairs in the Dining hall, where there is more space.
